


Figure 1-Rear Seat Belt Retractor Trim Panel-Four - Door Models




Figure 2-Front Seat Belt Trim Bezel-Two - Door Models




Figure 3—Rear Quarter Interior Trim Panel—Two - Door Models




Figure 4-Rear Seat Belt Lower Anchor Bolt-Typical





Figure 5-Rubber Stopper-Two - Door Models




Figure 7—Rear Seat Belt Retractor Trim Cover—Two - Door Models




Figure 8-B-Pillar Lower Trim Panel-Two -Door Models




Figure 9-B-Pillar Upper Trim Panel-Two -Door Models




Figure 10--Rear Door Sill Plate




Figure 11-Rocker Panel Trim Covers-Two -Door Model Shown, Four - Door Model Similar




Figure 12-Rocker Panel Front Trim Cover




Figure 13—Rocker Panel Rear Trim Cover—Two - Door Model Shown, Four - Door Model Similar




Figure 14—Fuel Filler Door—Four - Door Model Shown,
